# PREMIER HEALTH SCREENING What's included my Premier Health Screening package?

Your Premier package includes a fitness assessment (with pulse oximetry), blood tests for liver and kidney function, full lipid panel and check for preventable diabetes, 10-year heart disease and stroke risk assessment, BMI, Body fat readings and resting ECG (electrocardiogram) test. Your haematology test provides insight into the composition of your blood and you'll also receive a check for thyroid function. In addition (new for 2019), you'll also receive tailored clinical advice from our multi-disciplinary medical panel made up from CBT therapist, Nutritionists, Dietitians, Physiotherapist, Wellness Coaches and GPs.

# FAQs

#### Are the Health Screenings confidential?

Yes. Your results are confidential and will only be provided to you.

#### Where will my screening take place?

For your convenience Bluecrest offers over 2,000 clinics across the UK.

#### How do I arrange a Health Screen?

Once the election window has closed, an eligibility list will be sent to Bluecrest and they will then contact you to arrange your Health Screen.

#### What happens during my Health Screening?

At your Bluecrest health check, you can expect a professional, reliable, private and confidential experience. After signing in at a reception area, you will be invited into a private consulting room where staff will take your measurements, blood pressure, a blood sample, and

they may also perform an ECG. You can rest assured that your tests are painless and you don't even need to remove any clothing.

#### What do I need to do before Screening?

We have recently upgraded our testing so you do not need to fast prior to your appointment but you can choose to do so if you wish.

If you choose not to fast:

- Drink plenty of water because this helps maintain blood circulation making it easier for our clinicians to take your blood sample.
- You may continue to eat and drink as you normally would and please continue to take any prescribed medications, but avoid vitamins and supplements as these can affect some results.

If you choose to fast:

- You must fast for 12 hours and tell your clinician on the day that you are fasting so they can modify your blood analysis accordingly.
- Drink plenty of water because this helps maintain blood circulation making it easier for our clinicians to take your blood sample.
- Please continue to take any prescribed medications as normal but avoid any vitamins or supplements as these can affect some results.

#### How long does it take?

We advise to allow around 30 minutes for your check. More time is spent after your appointment when our cardiac specialists will check your heart readings and our laboratory will analyse your blood. Once all you results are collated will we post your detailed report explaining everything with advice written by our chief medical advisor.

#### What happens if I need to change or cancel my appointment?

Please ensure you check your availability before confirming the date of your Health Screen. Bluecrest will always be pleased to rearrange appointment dates and times, however if you fail to attend on the day, they cannot guarantee being able to accommodate you on a future date.

#### Can I access my comprehensive report online?

Yes, as well as receiving a high quality hard copy of your report, you will also be able to access it securely online anywhere or any time where you have access to an internet connection.
